OBITUARIES

Author, lawyer and lecturer was man of style and substance

JAMES KENNETH AITKEN
SOLICITOR
28-2-1921 — 24-4-2009

KEN Aitken, an author and expert lawyer in conveyancing, wills and estates of the deceased — and one of the last of the great gentlemen — has died of prostate cancer, aged 88.

For decades he was a lecturer on these subjects at Melbourne University, and wrote several books on the drafting of wills.

Later, as an authority on all 12 volumes of *A Remembrance of Things Past*, by Marcel Proust, an author profoundly abstruse to many, Aitken lectured at the University of the Third Age.

A master of courtesy and good manners, never did you see him in public without a tie. Right up until the last days, his extraordinary mind was still active, swiftly completing the puzzles in *The Age*.

Aitken was the eldest of five children and the family lived in a large comfortable house in Heyington Place, Toorak. He was 10 years old, and brother Bob, 9, when off they went to Geelong College as boarders.

Always modest and self-effacing, when asked how he went at Geelong, he said his studies were "reasonable" because he had a good memory. Reasonable was a piece of Aitken nonsense. He did so well he won a full scholarship to Ormond College, where he majored in English literature, philosophy and Latin.

World War II came and he joined up. He had spent four years in the school cadets with no promotion. This cured him of ever wanting to go into the army, so in 1941 he joined the RAAF. He trained in Southern Rhodesia (now Zimbabwe), graduated as an observer, navigator-bomb aimer and later as a commissioned officer, he joined 459 Squadron.

The squadron started with Hudsons, converted to Venturas and later to Baltimores. They roamed the Mediterranean looking for submarines and engaged in reconnaissance and daylight bombing in the Aegean.

Aitken returned to Australia as a flight lieutenant. His scholarship was still available at Ormond, but he didn't continue with philosophy. If a drama director were casting for a professor of philosophy, Aitken would have been ideal, but it was not to be. He was surrounded by lawyers. His grandfather was a barrister. His father, Phillip, was a solicitor and partner in the firm Aitken Walker and Strachan. His brothers Bob and Philip both became lawyers. So it was inevitable. He switched to the law.

In the middle of his studies, Aitken's sister, Virginia, introduced him to Sylvia James, and they were married at St John's, Toorak, in August, 1947. The rent on their flat was four guin-

ees a week, almost his entire income, so he made ends meet working part-time as a reporter on the now defunct *Argus*.

It was exciting and he contemplated journalism as a career, but that was also not to be. "I wasn't good enough," he said. "I couldn't do the foot-in-the-door stuff." He graduated with a law degree (LLB) in 1948, and added a masters (LLM) in 1949; Sylvia became a bachelor of science.

In 1951, Aitken became a partner in the firm Russell Kennedy and Cook, and remained there until 1986. However, he held a practising certificate right up until the time of his death. One of his partners described his depth of legal knowledge as astonishing. His dedication to the law was such that when he was on holidays his partner asked for advice. Aitken sent back a message: "I am lying in the sun reading amendments to the Victoria stamp duties legislation."

Maybe it was the philosophy or maybe it was his days on the *Argus*, but Aitken remained fascinated by the printed word. He was passionate about Proust. There was one comforting thing about Proust, he loved madeleines, the little French cakes. Patricia Rumbold, a master cook, baked madeleines that were served after the memorial service, in honor of Aitken and, of course, Proust.

Aitken's mind was always working. He did a refresher course in navigation at RMIT, and then he flew with his friend Boz Parsons in a recreation of Francis Chichester's flight from Norfolk Island to Lord Howe Island. They did this using old style instruments in the manner of Captain Cook, and like the noble captain they found their little island.

Aitken was a member at Royal Melbourne Golf Club, yet all his life he never owned a full set of clubs. It was more important to spend money on good

books, and they had to be hard-backs. When his son Michael was born, Aitken was out on the course and the hospital could not contact him. He was winning the Spring Medal. Golfers will appreciate the importance of his comment: "I now have three sons but only one golf medal."

Aitken was a formidable opponent on the tennis court, very crafty indeed. He was formidable at bridge, but he was truly to be feared at Scrabble. His memory bank was filled with horrid two-letter words and there were times when he plunked down a tile achieving an amazing 130 points.

Last year the Aitkens celebrated 60 years of happy marriage. He is survived by Sylvia, children Susie, Charles, David and Michael, and nine grandchildren.
